In 2023, we connected more clinicians to training, built more culturally contextual resources, and directly supported the health of individuals in underserved communities, more than ever before.



Connecting Patientswith Essential Care

MCN's <u>Health Network</u> (HN) associates create a link between mobile patients and health care providers across the country. In 2023, their efforts ensured



1,710 people were provided care coordination.

About 68% of Health Network patients last year needed prenatal care.



284 babies were born to migrants that received care through Health Network.

In collaboration with Uber's ride service, HN was able to remove one of the many barriers to care by providing patients with

free rides to health care appointments.
