Health Network provides continuity of care services, medical records transfer, and follow-up services for patients who leave your service area. This important and effective service ensures we have a healthy agricultural workforce as the season progresses. It also assists clinicians to better serve patients after a disaster or other emergency, as people temporarily or semi-permanently leave their community and arrive at a new one. Health Network has proven to be an easily modifiable patient navigation system with application in disease surveillance and treatment management for any number of injuries, illnesses, or care needs.
