POLICY TITLE: ELECTROCARDIOGRAPH

POLICY STATEMENT:

Health Center will provide Electrocardiograph testing as deemed

medically necessary.

PROCEDURE:

A. Purpose

- 1. To evaluate the cardiac status of patients presenting with symptoms
- 2. To obtain baseline cardiac function

B. Equipment

- 1. EKG machine
- 2. Electrodes
- 3. Gown

C. Steps

- 1. Wash hands
- 2. Explain the procedure to the patient
- 3. Ask the patient to remove shirt (bra) and apply gown allowing access to chest
- 4. Apply electrodes as per diagram (located on the EKG cart)
- 5. Connect EKG leads as per diagram
- 6. Turn machine on and enter patient information as requested
- 7. Run EKG strip
- 8. Allow the practitioner to review
- 9. Once approved, disconnect leads and remove electrodes
- 10. Instruct the patient to get dressed
- 11. Circle EKG on the encounter form
