
What to Expect When Getting the COVID-19 Vaccine

Continue to wear a mask, wash your hands, and maintain your distance.






It's free for most everyone, including immigrants. <u>No ID is</u> <u>required</u> to get the vaccine.




You will start to feel better after a couple of days.
